Hay Show Conditions of Entry.

*Dressage and Combined Training entries close on Monday 25th July. (Late entries may be accepted if space allows.)
Entries for all other classes on the day.*

No Entry will be accepted without the correct entry fee.

For Safety reasons, all stallions must wear a rosette sized 'Stallion' disc on their bridle at ALL times whilst on the showground. Discs available from the Secretary (British Eventing, British Dressage & BSJA discs are acceptable).

All colts 2 years old and over MUST be bitted.

Hay Show has zero tolerance towards rough handling or abuse of any animal whatsoever.

The judge's, steward's or committee's decision will be final.

The Committee do not accept responsibility for any loss or accident to any horse, rider, spectator or vehicle of any description.

The Committee reserve the right to alter the schedule or programme of events according to their requirements.

Any objection must be lodged within 15 minutes of the end of the class and accompanied by a deposit of £25.00.

Where age limits apply, competitors may be required to produce proof of age.

All horses competing under saddle must be 4 years old or over.

Suitable shoes with a hard heel, and an Approved riding hat which complies with current safety standards must be worn at all times by Any person whilst mounted.

*All dogs on the showground must be kept on a lead. **Any dog found wandering may be collected from the Secretary for a fee of £10 which will be donated to the Air Ambulance.***

The Secretary retains the right to refuse entry for any reason agreed by the Committee.

Every rider has to pay a £2 contribution towards First Aid costs.

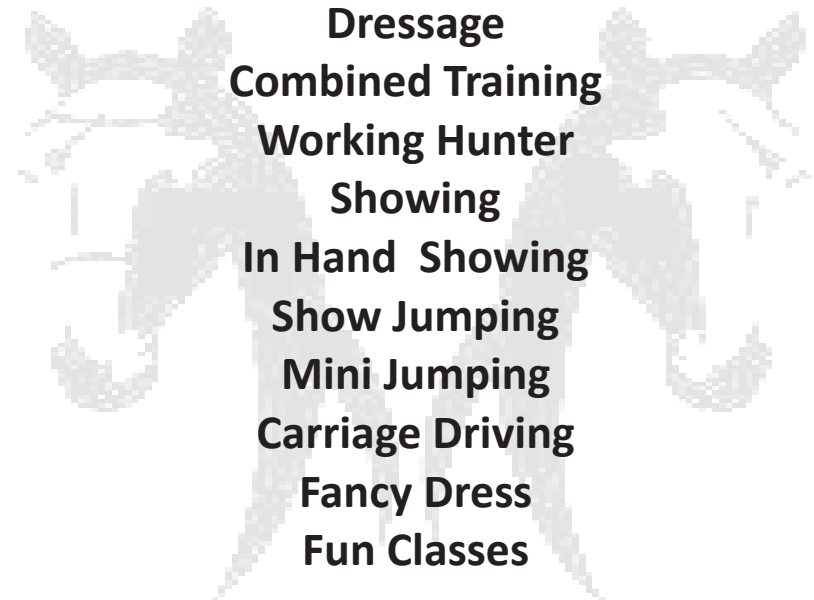

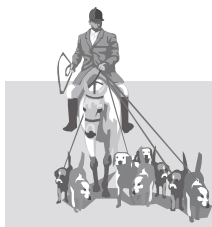

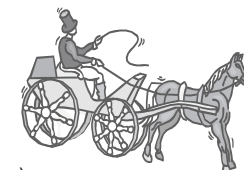

Entry £5.00 Rosettes to 6th place.

The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate any of the following classes.
All horses/ponies must be 4 years and over, except class 70.

Class

- 70) HORSE or PONY IN HAND, suitable to drive in Harness. Any age.
Special rosette for best yearling or 2 year old.
Handlers of colts must be 14 yrs old or over.
- 71) MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND PONY, to any suitable vehicle.
- 72) NOVICE WHIP Open to any size horse/pony to any suitable vehicle.
Novice Whip not to have won more than two classes up to date of entry.
- 73) DISABLED or JUNIOR WHIP Open to any size horse or pony to any suitable vehicle. Disabled and Junior Whip to be judged separately.
- 74) EXERCISE VEHICLE CLASS Open to any horse/pony to any suitable exercise vehicle.
- 75) RIDE AND DRIVE
To be judged on gait and suitability in both disciplines. Open to any horse/pony to any suitable vehicle.
Part 1. Drive.

 (Riders in class 61 may not compete in class 30.)
- 62) **BEST MANNERED PONY.** (Stand still, pick up feet, lead etc)

- 64) **BARREL JUMPING** (starts at 30cm-1') One barrel removed from the line each round.
- 65) **BARREL RACING** (go on, have a go - fastest round the barrels wins!)
